

Swamp Rabbit Bridge and Trail

Greenville, SC

The Swamp Rabbit Trail is a walking/ bicycle trail that makes it's way from Traveler's Rest to Greenville, SC. A new 170 ft long bridge is under construction to bring the trail over the Reedy River. Predrilled, concreted H-piles were originally proposed for support of the bridge. WEC offered a more cost competitive micropile foundation system and was awarded the project.

9-5/8" OD micropiles were drilled into the underlying bedrock to resist compressive, uplift and lateral loads. Some piles were battered for increased lateral resistance.
